Disclaimer of Liability

The 2016 Kiwi raid and regatta is a closed club event and all participants need to be members of Raid New Zealand Incorporated. The Club will be providing limited assistance with accommodation and food, but while reasonable efforts will be made by the club to offer support when the participants are on the water, skippers are reminded that the safety and wellbeing of themselves and crew is their responsibility at all times and any decisions to put to sea or not is at their total and sole discretion.

Each boat must be equipped and manned in a manner each skipper and crew consider safe and adequate. The Club requires that each boat must carry minimum safety equipment which will include:

PFD's for all persons on-board. (note: these are required to be worn at all times in vessels under 6 meters)

Two means of communication including Handheld VHF radio.

Appropriate Chart and compass.

Bailer or bucket.

Suitable Anchor and chain and a min of 30 meters line.

Sunscreen & Drinking water
